

FRIENDS OF WINEBRENNER SCHOLARSHIP

Winebrenner is pleased to offer the opportunity for current and incoming students to apply for the Friends of Winebrenner Scholarship. This scholarship is provided through the generous support of multiple long-time supporters of Winebrenner and is intended to assist current and incoming students in their pursuit of a graduate degree.

For the 19-20 academic year (beginning fall 2019), there are **four \$1000 scholarships available**. Winebrenner will award two \$1000 scholarships to incoming students and two \$1000 scholarships to current students who are/will be enrolled in the Master of Arts in Practical Theology program. The scholarship monies are intended for the 19-20 academic year only and will be divided evenly amongst the three trimesters for each recipient.

To apply, submit an essay of 750 words or less covering the following topics:

- a. How you will use the scholarship to assist in meeting the financial responsibility of your enrollment at Winebrenner?
- b. Why are you pursuing a graduate degree and in what ways do you see this education benefitting you in your current and/or future ministry?

Submit the essay and application electronically to Amy Kinney, Director of Enrollment Management, at Winebrenner Theological Seminary, 950 N. Main St. Findlay, Ohio NO LATER than **July 20, 2019**. Electronic submission is also accepted; kinney@winebrenner.edu

The following are the eligibility requirements:

- Maintain “Satisfactory Academic Progress” as defined by the Academic Catalog
- Be enrolled at a minimum of half-time (3 credit hours)
- Plan to enroll in all three trimesters of the 19-20 academic year
- Be in good standing with the Seminary (for current students)

Recipients of the scholarship will be notified by the Seminary no later than August 10, 2019.
