Note: The United States has 11 federal holidays. Federal holidays are days the federal government recognizes by closing its offices and giving federal employees the day off. For Winebrenner to get 12 weeks in a trimester without disturbing certain family-oriented or Christian-centric holidays (e.g., Thanksgiving, Christmas, Easter) we must hold classes on some federal holidays such as Columbus Day, Veterans Day, and Presidents Day.
